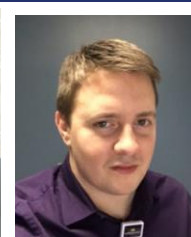

2 Additional COVID-19 Codes becoming Effective April 1, 2022

CMS is implementing 2 new procedure codes, in addition to the 7 new procedure codes previously announced for ICD-10-PCS. These new codes are for introduction or infusion of therapeutics, including vaccines for COVID-19.

2 new codes

Procedure Code	Description	*O.R.	MDC	MS-DRG
XW023X7	Introduction of tixagevimab and cilgavimab monoclonal antibody into muscle, percutaneous approach, new technology group 7	N		
XW023Y7	Introduction of other new technology monoclonal antibody into muscle, percutaneous approach, new technology group 7	N

Coding Spotlight

Surgical Global Package Review

What is a surgical global package?

- Includes all necessary services normally furnished by a surgeon pre-operative, intra-operative and post-operative.
- Inpatient hospital, outpatient hospital, ambulatory surgery centers, and physician offices.

Global Surgical Package Classifications

0-Day	10-Day	90-Day
No pre- or post-op period.	No pre-op period	1 day pre-op period
Visit on day of service not typically separately reportable.	Visit on day of service not typically separately reportable.	Visit on day of service not typically separately reportable.
	Total days is 11 = day of surgery, including 10 days immediately following.	Total days is 92 = day before surgery, day of surgery, including 90 days immediately following.

What is included?

- Pre-op visits after decision was made to operate.
- Intra-operative services that are normal to the procedure.
- Medical and surgical services required by the physician due to complication without return to the OR.
- Follow-up visits related to recovery.
- Post-surgical pain management by surgeon.
- Supplies except those identified by exclusions.
- Miscellaneous services - Examples: stitches/staple removal, dressing changes, tubes, drains, and catheter removals, etc.

What can be billed separately?

- Initial consult or evaluation by a surgeon for determination for need for major procedures.
- Visits unrelated to the surgical procedure unless due to complication of surgery.
- Treatment for underlying condition or added course of treatment not part of the normal recovery.
- Complications that result in return to the operating room.
- More than 1 provider involved.

Modifiers

- **24** - Unrelated Service by the same physician during a post-operative period.
- **25** - Used to bill separately identifiable E/M service by the same physician on the same day of the procedure.
- **57** - Decision for Surgery
- **58** - Staged or related procedure or service by same physician or Health Care Professional during post-op period.
- **78** - Unplanned return to the operating room by same physician or Health Care Professional for related procedure during post operative period.
- **79** - Unrelated procedure or service by same physician or other qualified Health Care Professional during post-operative period.

Multiple Providers Involved

- 1 physician provides all care - Bill Global Surgical Package
- Provider A performs the surgery, and Provider B follows post-op. Provider A and B are in the same group. Bill Global Package with Provider A as the performing provider.
- Provider C performs the surgery and has a written transfer agreement that Provider D will follow-up with the patient for post-op care. Provider C and D work in separate Groups.
- Modifiers that can be used with a written transfer agreement - add to CPT code of procedure.
 - 54 - Surgical care only
 - 55 - Postoperative management only
 - 56 - preoperative management only

Return to Operating Room

Must be equipped and staffed for sole purpose of providing procedures.

- Includes: Cardiac catheterization suite, laser suite, endoscopy suite.
- Excludes: Patient room, minor treatment room, recovery room or intensive care unit.

Reporting Routine Post-Operative Visits

- 99024 - Postoperative follow-up visit. Included in surgical package.

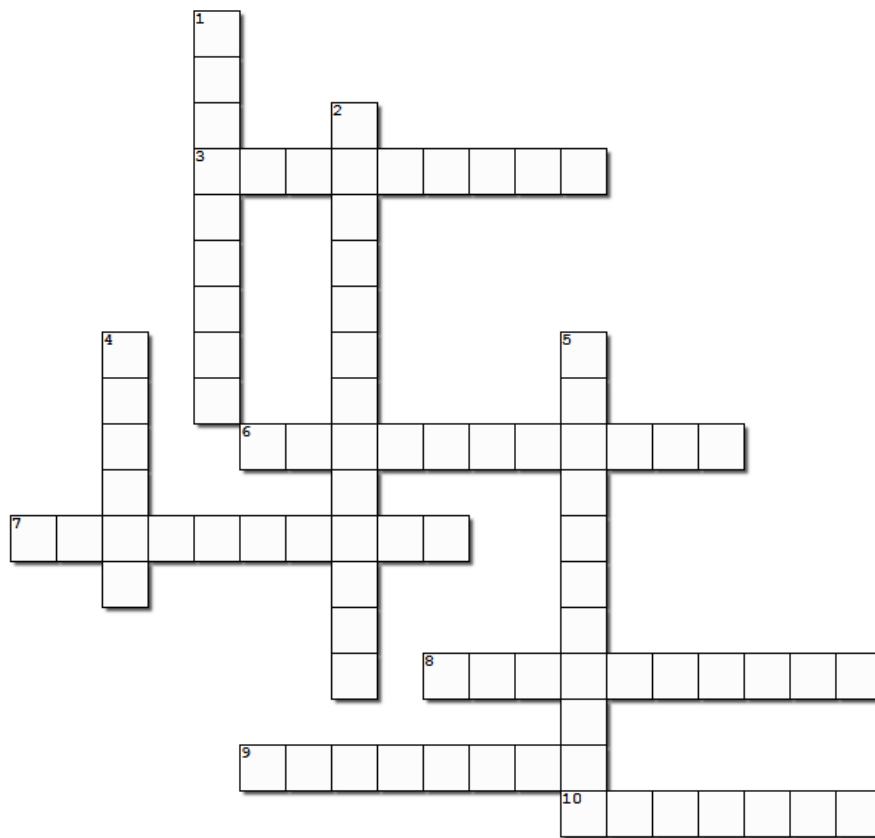
